

2018/19 Illawarra Hawks played in the first ever Indigenous Jersey adopted by an NBL team, representing the Dharawal people, the traditional custodians of this land.



Founded in 1979, the only remaining Foundation Club of the NBL.



Made the playoffs in 22 of the 44 seasons, including the last two seasons.



2000/01 Club won its first NBL championship under coach Brendan Joyce.








